**DIRECTIONS:**

Soap Degradar should be used heavily at first if there is an accumulation of soaps present in the system, then dosages should be reduced to maintenance levels.

4" (10 cm) - 1 oz. (29 ml)/10 ft (3 meters)  
6" (15 cm) - 2 oz. (58 ml)/10 ft (3 meters)

**GREASE TRAPS**

32 oz. (946 ml) per  
500 gals. (1892 liters)  
Monthly

**SEPTIC TANKS/CESSPOOLS**

1 gal. (3.78 liters) per  
500 gals. (1892 liters)  
every 3 - 4 Months

This product is most effective when applied at the end of the day, or at least when water use is at a minimum. Apply through floor drain, sink or directly to system.

Also, because Soap Degradar is a bacterial product, high concentrations of chlorine or other sanitizing agents should be avoided, or at a minimum, not introduced to the system at the same time.
